STAFFING UPDATE

We are delighted to share that we will again host a Newly Qualified Teacher (NQT) in session 2021-22. Whilst we do not know their name yet, we look forward to them joining West Linton School, The NQT will be supported by Mrs Maclennan.

Miss Skinner will be leaving us after the summer break and continuing her leadership journey in her first promoted post. Miss Skinner has led many school wide initiatives, notably the co-ordination of the move to online learning in the lead up to the national lockdown. We will miss Miss Skinner's IT knowledge, her enthusiasm for our school and commitment to our children, but wish her luck in her new post.

Mrs Nicola Smith will return to school, after her maternity leave in the new school year. She will work part time between August and December, but will return to full time teaching after the Christmas break. I know you will join me in welcoming Mrs Smith back to West Linton Primary School.

We move into the new school year with three teaching vacancies; the first will be to cover a Monday and Tuesday when Mrs Smith is not in school.

Whilst Mrs Butler plans to return to school in session 2021-22, it will be towards the end of the year and therefore a vacancy has been advertised for the duration of her maternity leave.

Mrs Harper will join the staff at Peebles High School as an ANA and we wish her lots of luck in her onward journey as an educator.
